Nadim was the 'deck monkey'. "Now we take turns. I like to raise the sails."

Word of Escandar's entrance into the world spread quickly throughout the docks. Marci relates, "Afterwards some friends came by and brought champagne and ice cream... people came all day. It was a lot of fun."

"We stayed for five days after the birth and then sailed home. We sailed back in one day. It was an easy trip. We put Escandar in a hammock and he sailed back in that a good part of the time. Perfect rocking motion."

"He has really taken to the sea. We've gone out sailing a lot since then and he's really comforted by the easy motion of the boat."
